We are happy to report that there is more good news regarding Rick Corman's multiple myeloma. He just completed his post-transplant chemotherapy regimen and had another negative PET/CT scan today. His latest bloodwork also shows that his disease is in complete remission. Rick continues to take some "maintenance" chemotherapy to help keep the disease in remission. Aside from some minor problems with tendinitis from weight lifting and some nerve damage from the chemotherapy, he is in great shape. He recently ran his 5K at under 21 mins.!

The research at Harvard that is partly funded by the R. J. Corman Multiple Myeloma Research Fund continues to develop exciting new cancer fighting medications. Although we expect that Rick will have a long remission on his current therapy, it is encouraging to see all the new drugs that will be available should he have another relapse.
